#### \*CALL TO WORSHIP:

L: Moses went up a mountain and talked with God. When he came down again, his face was shining, and the people would not come near him because they were afraid of this change in his appearance. Moses' transfiguration, or the change in his outward form or appearance, was frightening to them.

### P: We can understand their fear. One's face does not ordinarily shine brightly.

L: Jesus took Peter, James, and John up a mountain. There they met Moses and Elijah, both of whom had been dead for hundreds of years. Jesus's face and clothes changed and became very bright. His disciples were terrified. Again, this transfiguration was a frightening event.

### P: Again, we can understand their fear. Such changes are not natural!

L: As Moses was transfigured, and as Jesus was transfigured, should not we, as we follow Jesus, be transfigured? Our transfiguration is unlikely to involve glowing faces and blinding white clothing, but should we not be changed as we follow Jesus, enough so that people can see the changes in us?

P: O God, we pray that our lives may be transfigured by Your spirit, so that others can witness the impact of Jesus in our actions, our words, and the manner in which we live our lives.
